It is held on the campus of Schreiner University in Kerrville, Texas. The NDC is NOT designed as a boot camp, but cadets WILL experience the intensity and rigor of a military-style drill camp. The event will be hard work, both mentally and physically at times, but this camp is designed to be an enjoyable experience from beginning to end!

The NDC will also include recreation and leadership components. Each camper participates in a mixture of classroom lessons and practical hands-on training every day. Campers will experience a wide variety of instruction that suits their individual tastes and preferences using both classroom and practical hands-on instruction. Campers will be members of a platoon that has all abilities within its structure. During certain sessions, cadets will be "ability grouped" to focus on their specific needs. This will allow cadets to gain overall instruction in all areas, as well as specific, in-depth instruction covering specific subjects. Classroom and practical instruction will be utilized and blended to provide an exceptional educational environment from start to finish.

In addition to the extensive drill work, all campers experience life on a college campus and life in a college dorm. Each cadet will participate within a range of activities that foster personal development and growth both mentally and physically.

Many are strictly skill-oriented, while others are geared toward social or mental goals, while others are dedicated almost exclusively to the entertainment of the attendees.
