

Dear Naval Science Instructor:

As the Event Manager, Sports Network International, Inc., would like to welcome your school to the 2010 NJROTC Nationals. In preparation for the event, SNI has developed this School Folder. The folder includes all of the information necessary for your school to compete at the 2010 NJROTC Nationals, including the NJROTC Nationals Event SOP and scoresheets (located in Sections 4 & 5, respectively).

There is a Schedule of Dates and Deadlines for Paperwork and Finances (page 1-4) which breaks down all of the necessary paperwork and when it must be sent in. This form also notes when SNI will be sending out other follow-up information between now and the event. Additionally, your school must **IMMEDIATELY** fill out and send in the Event Registration Form for your school.

We have enhanced our website to include event specific information for teams attending the Navy Nationals. You can check on your paperwork and financial status as well as enter your Master Participant List and team rosters. There will be paperwork that you still need to mail to our office, but we hope that you find this website helpful as you organize for this trip.

**Your next deadline is March 10th, 2010.** In addition to the paperwork due on that date, this is also the deadline for the package fees and meal plan fees.

The Acceptance of Responsibility (page 1-5) **MUST BE NOTARIZED** and submitted before the deadline. Schools will not be allowed to compete without submitting this form duly notarized.

#### **A NOTE ABOUT FAXES**

SNI does have a fax machine and schools are permitted to send in the occasional missing form by fax. However, since the Acceptance of Responsibility form cannot be received by fax (it must be sent to us as a notarized original through the mail), schools should plan to mail ALL paperwork in one package. However, should you need to fax a missing form, feel free to do so. But don't forget that the March 10th deadline for paperwork means ...

**A NOTE ABOUT PAPERWORK:** Before you send anything in the mail to SNI you **MUST MAKE COPIES** to keep for your files (in case they get lost in the mail). SNI also encourages schools to contact SNI either an hour after faxing documents or several days after mailing documents to make sure they were received.

# Event Management of NJROTC Nationals

The NJROTC Nationals – Academic, Athletic & Drill Championships maintains the reputation as a prestigious, well-rounded competition for the finest Navy JROTC programs in the country. In the past, the responsibility for coordinating and running this massive undertaking has fallen upon the host Area Manager along with a host facility (usually a university or naval base).

To assist NETC (Naval Education and Training Command) and the host Area Manager, NETC has contracted Sports Network International to coordinate and manage the NJROTC Nationals since 1999. SNI has produced the event S.O.P. and event scoresheets for the NJROTC Nationals under the direction and supervision of NETC.

Sports Network International (SNI) is Event Manager for the **National High School Drill Team Championships**, held annually in early May in Daytona Beach, Florida. This drill meet is nationally-recognized as the finest all-service drill meet in the world. SNI is also the Event Manager for the **U.S. Army Cadet Command Championships**, as well as the **Air Force National JROTC Drill Championships**, the Western Championships are held in San Antonio, TX and while the Eastern Championships are held in Upper Marlboro, MD. SNI also hosts Summer drill camps as well. These camps give cadets with a passion for all aspects of competition drill a 7-day fantasy drill experience. We have to date hosted over 90 drill & ceremony competitions involving over 250,000 cadets from around the world. Our latest effort within the drill community is the hosting of the new DrillNATION website. This site glorifies cadets and instructors involved in all facets of JROTC competitions. All Navy Nationals attending schools are encouraged to register on the site free of charge today – <http://www.DrillNATION.net>.

In managing the NJROTC Nationals, SNI is responsible to produce this event folder for all participating schools. SNI will receive all event paperwork and fees from all schools and process them for the event. SNI will provide NETC with all meal information for the schools. The Area Manager will work closely with Mark Watson and Cindy Raske (NETC) to coordinate ground transportation and assistance with securing billeting. Should you have detailed questions regarding billeting, meals or ground transportation, they should be directed to either Mark Watson or Cindy Raske.

As Event Manager, SNI will handle SOP questions, preparing meal arrangements, event scheduling, judges training, competition venue set-up, Event Registration, distribution of event package materials (shirts & medallions), scoresheet tabulation, production of trophies and awards, as well as most other aspects of running a meet the size and scope of the NJROTC Nationals. ## Master Roster of Cadets

As a school entering the 2010 NJROTC Nationals, there are two requirements to compete at the NJROTC Nationals which can both be accomplished by one letter. Sports Network would like you to follow the example on this page when making out your own Master Roster. It is requested that this letter be done on school or JROTC letterhead stationery.

1. Each school/program at the NJROTC Nationals is required to present a "Master Roster" for competition. This roster consists of all cadets participating from your school.
2. This same letter should specify that all cadets listed below are enrolled in this school, and are currently enrolled in the NJROTC program. This letter should be signed by the Naval Science Instructor of your program.
3. This form is due with all other paperwork on March 10th, 2010. **Should you have any changes in the Master Roster (substitutions, additions, etc.), you should update your letter and send any revisions as necessary.**
4. All cadets on this roster will be required to participate in the Unit Personnel Inspection event.
